



Health and Safety Training for Temporary Structure Contractors

StructureSafe is a one-day health and safety training course run by MUTA. It is aimed at educating and promoting health and safety best practice for temporary structures site crew. The course covers:

- ✓ **Overview of H&S legislation**
- ✓ **H&S documentation**
- ✓ **Risk assessment process**
- ✓ **Principles of a safe place of work**
- ✓ **Electric hazards**
- ✓ **Safe use of machinery**
- ✓ **Overhead and underground services**
- ✓ **Workplace transport**
- ✓ **Personal protection equipment**
- ✓ **Working at height**

Upon completion of the course, candidates will sit a short in-house test to evidence their understanding of what they have learned on the course and if they pass they will receive a nationally recognised StructureSafe certificate.

Course Cost:

£40 +VAT per person for MUTA members.

£130 +VAT per person for non-members.

Courses, of between 10 and 20 candidates, are organised around the country in response to demand – we can even hold them at your premises.
